The Anointed One and His Anointing is Here

Scriptures referred to throughout the sermon:

Matthew 16:18

I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

Exodus 7:10

So Moses and Aaron came to Pharaoh, and thus they did just as the Lord had commanded; and Aaron threw his staff down before Pharaoh and his servants, and it became a serpent.

Exodus 14:21

Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD swept the sea back by a strong east wind all night and turned the sea into dry land, so the waters were divided.

2 Kings 2:8

Elijah took his mantle and folded it together and struck the waters, and they were divided here and there, so that the two of them crossed over on dry ground.

2 Kings 13:21

As they were burying a man, behold, they saw a marauding band; and they cast the man into the grave of Elisha. And when the man touched the bones of Elisha he revived and stood up on his feet.

2 Kings 5:10

Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, "Go and wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh will be restored to you and you will be clean."

Mark 10:46-52

Then they came to Jericho. And as He was leaving Jericho with His disciples and a large crowd, a blind beggar named Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, was sitting by the road. When he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Many were sternly telling him to be quiet, but he kept crying out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" And Jesus stopped and said, "Call him here." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage, stand up! He is calling for you." Throwing aside his cloak, he jumped up and came to Jesus. And answering him, Jesus said, "What do you want Me to do for you?" And the blind man said to Him, "Rabboni, I want to regain my sight!" And Jesus said to him, "Go; your faith has made you well." Immediately he regained his sight and began following Him on the road.

Luke 8:49-56

While He was still speaking, someone came from the house of the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; do not trouble the Teacher anymore." But when Jesus heard this, He answered him, "Do not be afraid any longer; only believe, and she will be made well." When He came to the house, He did not allow anyone to enter with Him, except Peter and John and James, and the girl's father and mother. Now they were all weeping and lamenting for her; but He said, "Stop weeping, for she has not died, but is asleep." And they began laughing at Him, knowing that she had died. He, however, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Child, arise!" And her spirit returned, and she got up immediately; and He gave orders for something to be given her to eat. Her parents were amazed; but He instructed them to tell no one what had happened.

John 11:43

When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth."

Esther 4:14

For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place and you and your father's house will perish. And who knows whether you have not attained royalty for such a time as this?"

Exodus 1:15-19

Then the king of Egypt spoke to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other was named Puah; and he said, "When you are helping the Hebrew women to give birth and see them upon the birthstool, if it is a son, then you shall put him to death; but if it is a daughter, then she shall live." But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt had commanded them, but let the boys live. So the king of Egypt called for the midwives and said to them, "Why have you done this thing, and let the boys live?" The midwives said to Pharaoh, "Because the Hebrew women are not as the Egyptian women; for they are vigorous and give birth before the midwife can get to them."

After man's downfall, as a result of sin, rust, moth, dust and death ruled over the children of men. **But God had a plan.** Before eternity past, the Lord of Hosts had devised a strategy to bring humanity back into relationship with Him – **through the Anointed One and His anointing.**

God already had a plan in place.

There were glimpses here and there of His presence and types and shadows of His omnipotence.

We need to get our plans in place.

Who was this Anointed One?

- Abel's sacrifice
- Noah's rainbow
- Abraham well
- Jacobs ladder
- Hezekiah's sundial
- Judah's scepter
- Jeremiah's vision (a wheel within a wheel)
- The 4th man in the fiery furnace

Peter would later describe Jesus through the eyes of the Spirit as “the Christ, the Son of the living God!”

It was upon this rock of revelation that the Son of Man proclaimed, “I will build My church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.” (**Matthew 16:18**)

Throughout the ages, **His tangible anointing** had also been present in everything from a *staff* to a *shadow*.

The anointing was present in Moses' staff as it turned to a serpent before in Moses' staff as it turned to a serpent before Pharaoh's eyes. (**Exodus 7:10**)

It parted the Red Sea, so the Israelites could cross on dry ground. (**Exodus 14:21**)

It was found in Elijah's mantle as he parted the Jordan River (**2 Kings 2:8**). It clung like a blanket to Elijah's bones long after he left this earth (**2 Kings 13:21**). It was in the Jordan River in which Naaman, the leper, was commanded by the prophet to dip seven times in order to be healed (**2 Kings 5:10**). It was in Peter's shadow and Paul's handkerchief and aprons.

This is the anointing and the Anointed One we are talking about.

The anointing of the Anointed One is in you.

We are living in that anointing.

The same anointing that was upon Jesus, Himself, as He walked the cobblestone streets of Jerusalem, is present in this final hour upon the earth. The same anointing that healed blind Bartimaeus (**Mark 10:46-52**), raised Jarius' daughter (**Luke 8:49-56**) and called to life the four-day dead body of Lazarus (**John 11:43**), is the same power that is at work in the world today.

We must tap into it. It is this same anointing that is culminating in this last great outpouring the world will ever witness and experience before Jesus returns for His glorious, spotless bride, the Church in a cloud of glory.

Nothing is impossible.

If the Word says it, it can be done.

What are preachers preaching in these times? Watered down messages, diluted messages etc.

We don't need diluted messages.

We need accurate messages - messages that will change us from the inside out.

The anointing can cool the fever of an infant child. The anointing can heal a broken heart and mend a broken marriage. It can transport you through life's trials and tribulations when dying looks easy. The anointing, through the power of the Holy Spirit, can save the most hopeless and helpless soul. The anointing can make dead things live again!

I believe you will uncover God's miracle anointing for your life!

- You need to discover how to release the tangible anointing of the Holy Spirit in your life.
- You need to understand how you have an impartation of the anointing through a spiritual inheritance (***An inheritance must be claimed***).
- ***You must receive your breakthrough by activating God's miracle anointing in your life.***
- You need the anointing in your life for your breakthrough.

The anointing that we, the church, should be seeking is not born by self and circumstance. It is not ritual or religiosity. The anointing that we are seeking is not found in the creeds of creation, nor in the doctrines of humanity. The anointing we are seeking is not housed in a human vessel.

The anointing we are seeking comes from Christ, the Anointed One.

You and I must learn to walk and live in this kind of anointing. When you do, He will wrap you in robes of righteousness and crown you with crowns of glory.

For too long we have operated with yesterday's anointing. Time is pregnant, just about to give birth to the miracle harvest that you've been waiting on (health/marriage/children/family members/work).

Like Esther, you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this (***Esther 4:14***).

If you don't do it, God will find someone else.

Just like the Israelite women, when Pharaoh commanded the Egyptian midwives to kill their children, you are going to give birth to a miracle faster than the devil can stop you (***Exodus 1:15-19***)!

What is happening in you is greater than what is happening around you or to you.

Have you ever walked around with a load that seemed too heavy to bear? Have you ever stumbled under the weight of things you couldn't carry in your own human power?

Possibly you are looking for hope beyond the scope of human limitation. Maybe you are looking for a power beyond the doctors, lawyers and even preachers.

It is time for your yoke to be destroyed because of the anointing!

I like describing the anointing like falling into a pool of water. When you come out, there's no denying that you are wet. Everything you touch becomes wet and everywhere you walk becomes wet. Everyone around you knows that you are wet – and it's tangible!

Today, I believe it's time for depression to find out who is the Lord. It is time for sickness and malfunction to come into contact with the Lord of lords. It's time for the lost children, spouses and parents to meet the king of Kings!

The devil may try to tell you that you will never be free. He may try to deceive you into believing that you were destined to be bound by the burden of addiction or negative words spoken over your life, such as: "You will never amount to anything" or "Your loved ones will never be saved".

The devil has no authority over you. He cannot put anything on you that you do not receive.

Heaven is open. The outpouring of the anointing has come and a flood is heading your way. Time has literally become pregnant with your miracle, and it's time to receive God's miracle anointing for your life!
