What does a resolution mean?

resolution

- 1. a firm decision to do or not to do something.
- 2. the quality of being determined or resolute.

Similar:

- determination
- purpose
- commitment

There is nothing wrong with new year's resolutions, I think we sometimes lack the planning or determination to see our resolutions through.

I want to encourage you to set goals for 2021, but above that, I want to encourage you to set your goals in line with the Word of God.

I can promise you that His Word will change you, if you let it, if you pursue it diligently.

Romans 15:4

For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Let's evaluate ourselves, our lives and our relationship with God - where are we, what are we doing? Is this God's will for my life and if things are wrong in some areas, what does His word say about it?

If we are setting goals and commitments for our lives to be changed, we have to make sure that we align them with God's Word and His Will. Otherwise, we are building on sinking sand.

We cannot expect God's blessing or His protection if we are working against Him, we have to make sure that we are in line with Him.

How do we know if we are in line with God's will?

- His Word
- His voice
- Godly counsel (Someone who has your best interests at heart & who has had success or victory in the same area that you are seeking).

Relationship with God

John 4:23-24

But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

It says we MUST worship the Father in spirit and in truth.

IN SPIRIT & TRUTH: means the deepest and truest part of ourselves must worship God.

God does not want our acting or our surface worship, God wants our deep worship, He wants us to worship Him with every part of ourselves, even the deepest parts of ourselves, our spirit.
